Paul K. Buchmann, age 79, passed away on Sunday, April 14, 2013 at the Frances Mahon Deaconess Hospital in Glasgow, Montana.

Paul was born on June 22, 1933 in Wolf Point, Montana, the son of Paul Buchmann Sr. and Margareta Buchmann. He was raised on the farm 22 miles north of Nashua on the family homestead. Paul played basketball and football and graduated from Nashua High School in 1952. He was a member of the Boy Scouts and went to Valley Forge with 50,000 other scouts.

He enlisted in the US Army, serving from 1954 to 1956.

Paul married Mary Bengochea in Nashua on January 3, 1957. He continued farming until moving to Glasgow in 1989. He was an avid Nashua Porcupine basketball fan and attended State Class C Tournaments for over 20 years. Paul made wool rugs, collected coins, and served on the Farmers Union Elevator Board in Nashua and Harvest States Board in Glasgow. He enjoyed his coffee group every morning and attended many Farmers Union Conventions. He was a good Broncos fan and enjoyed the Boston Celtics.

Paul was preceded in death by two brothers; Karl and Gustav, and a sister Lucille Overby.
